

Policy for City of Verndale Brush Pile

The City of Verndale has created this policy because some residents have abused the use of the brush pile with unauthorized material being thrown onto the site, and with the keys not being returned.

Beginning immediately there will be a \$10.00 (cash) security deposit required to obtain a key from the City Hall.

The deposit will be returned to you when you return the key.

There will be a 2 day time limit for using a key. Friday thru Monday is acceptable also.

There are three separate piles for things to be disposed of. One pile contains leaves, grass clippings, and garden plant material. The bags used to hold the leaves or grass clippings must be taken with you.

The second pile is for brush. Branches, twigs, cut up trees, shrubs and tree stumps are acceptable.

The third thing that may be disposed of is cement pieces. Old broken up sidewalks, bricks or cement blocks are acceptable.

Unacceptable material to be disposed of is lumber, plywood and material from a house demolition or house remodeling.

Other unacceptable material is household garbage, furniture, appliances, tires, anything plastic or rubber, glass items, mattresses, etc..

Residents may feel free to use the compost material as it becomes available. The pile with the leaves is mixed regularly and the material turns into good black dirt after a couple years.

Residents who violate this policy will be fined for illegal dumping. They may be barred from future use of the brush pile.

The use of this brush pile is a privilege to the residents of Verndale. If abuse continues then the City may have to stop providing this privilege to the residents, or limit the times of using the brush pile so that we can monitor the material being disposed.

The City retains the right to refuse large quantities of any material.
